

2. <u>Approval of Curriculum Committee Special Meeting Minutes of June 26, 2025</u>

3. English Curriculum Review - Great Minds *Arts & Letters* Proposal
Pam Vecca, Principal of Plumb Hill Middle School (PHMS) and Melissa Swanson, PHMS ELA
Instructional Area Coordinator gave a presentation on a pilot adoption of the *Arts & Letters*curriculum (grades 6-8) for the 2025-2026 school year.

The presentation included but was not limited to the rationale for the change and selection of this curriculum, the launch of the pilot and teacher support, a review of sample texts, daily routine, costs and budgeting. Questions regarding the pilot were fielded by Pam Vecca, and Dr. Villar. The committee is comfortable with the one-year pilot. Ms. Vecca and her team will meet with the Curriculum Committee on a quarterly basis and provide an update on the pilot.

4. <u>Science Curriculum Review - OpenSciEd Proposal</u>
