
# REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT No. 20 SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES September 14, 2023



#### Curriculum Committee

1. <u>Call to Order</u> The Curriculum Committee meeting held at James Morris School and remotely was called to order at 4:34 p.m. by Alexandrea Papp.

# 2. Teacher Education of Mentoring (TEAM) Program

Mr. Leone opened by sharing there is a state statute requirement for new educators to participate in a mentoring program. The document put before the committee for its review and consideration is taking the best of the Litchfield Public Schools (LPS) and Region 6 (RSD6) model and creating a new model for Region 20. Discussion ensued. With no objections or edits from the committee, Emily Cole made a motion to bring the Teacher Education of Mentoring (TEAM) Program to the full Board for approval. Alexandrea Papp seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. This will be an Action Item for the full Board at its September 28, 2023 meeting.

# 3. Curriculum Committee Goal Setting (Draft)

Mr. Leone circulated a draft Curriculum Committee Goal prepared at the Admin Retreat for review and consideration. Discussion ensued. The committee agreed to the edited version of the goal that reads: Oversee a committee of teachers and administrators for the purpose of developing a curriculum that will provide students with a broad base of knowledge and skills. Such a curriculum will promote continuous personal growth and lifelong learning across all content areas and grade levels to be implemented in the school year beginning August 2024. This goal will go before the Long Term Planning Committee at the September 28, 2023, meeting for review.
