This charge is paid for an average of 180 calls a year. It was stated the LVA will only transport patients to Torrington Hospital or Waterbury Hospital. The First Selectman stated that the cost is what it is, we have no way to change it. The cost of the ambulance is \$38.00 @hr.

Dave Fenn made a motion that the BOF give the amount of \$5000.00 to Greenwood's Foundation, the amount they asked for. Phil seconded, all members voted in favor.

Adele made a motion that the BOF give the library the money they are looking for to replace 5 tower computers. This year the money will come out of capitol then next year become a line item. Dave seconded, all members in favor.

Tracy stated that she wants a vote on this budget tonight so it can go to a town meeting.

Adele made a motion to approve the budget in the amount of \$9,338,740.00 for the fiscal year 2022/2023, Phil made a second. All agreed in a vote, except Carrie that abstained!

Carrie made a motion that the public hearing on this budget be held on Thursday May 12, 2022 at 7:00pm at the Morris Town Hall. Adele seconded, all members voted in favor.
