Dear First Selectman Weik,

I am writing to formally request that the Morris Local Traffic Authority (LTA) review a safety concern on Thomaston Road and consider recommending the installation of a radar speed feedback sign to the CTDOT.

As a resident at 111 Thomaston Road, I have observed that vehicles frequently travel 20–30 mph over the posted speed limit, often even higher. This section of the road carries heavy traffic, including dump trucks, tankers, trailer trucks and by faster, smaller vehicles. The combination of high speeds and large commercial vehicles poses a significant danger to the many children and pets living along this stretch.

I previously contacted CTDOT regarding this issue, and they advised that such requests must first be reviewed by the Town's LTA. I am asking the LTA for Morris to conduct or request a speed study and, if appropriate, support the installation of a speed monitoring sign near my residence to improve driver awareness and safety.

I am available to provide additional details or meet on-site if helpful. Thank you for your time and attention to this matter.
