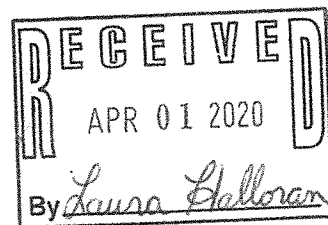

- Motion to approve minutes (RT, JM second)
- Camp Columbia Review
 - The state is looking to invest in CC and wants to get feedback from the Town of Morris
 - There is no current interest from the state right now to sell property.
 - The state may be opened to letting the town manage (own?) the boathouse land that's part of CC located on Bantam lake.
 - DEEP Parks and Rec are about to invest in the trail system on CC (across ~60 acres) and install history kiosks across the grounds and improve the trail conditions. Remaining buildings, TBD but they will maintain the tower.
 - DEEP Forestry service is actively managing the remainder of the property – it's more or less under conservation.
 - Key points from EDC to State
 - asked State to preserve as much history/architecture as possible, maintain safe and clean trails, consider trails widths that can accommodate
 - Requested that considerations be made for access in case of emergencies/etc.
 - Ron/Jason will continue to be Pont of Contact
 - EDC/State will continue open dialog via EDC

- Regional Tourism
 - Businesses/ideas can be shared with the now active Western CT Tourism Bureau and also Discover Litchfield Hills directly or via EDC
