Fire Department OSHA Citations Update- There has been no response from the Fire Department on the status of the OSHA violations.

After the tornados that swept through Connecticut, the Town of New Fairfield reached out to Morris for help. The First Selectman delivered 100 cases of water and a generator to the New Fairfield.
