March, 2026

The regular March 12, 2026 meeting was called to order by the chair at 4:05 pm downstairs in the Community Hall. Present were Connie Trolle, Doreen Gagnon, Clif Wheeler, and Mike Doyle. Robin Viola was unable to attend. Also present were Scott Meyers, Anthony LoFrisco, and Mark Conlon.

The minutes of the regular February 12, 2026 meeting were accepted as written.

New Business

There was no new business.

Old Business

Application 26-01 from Anthony LoFrisco to improve the existing access wetland crossing, add a fire pond, add electrical conduit and install solar panels at 96 Stoddard Road was considered. The existing 12" pipe will be replaced with two 24" pipes. Mr. LoFrisco stated he would route any conduit from the solar array along the driveway. He submitted a pond plan dated March 6, 2026, showing the proposed pond on both sides of the drive - .14 acres on the upslope side, and .51 acres on the down slope side - with the excavated material used to dam the downslope side. A spillway and swale are detailed on the plan as well as a dry hydrant. On a motion by Connie Trolle, seconded by Clif Wheeler, it was **VOTED** unanimously to approve this application that should have minimum impact to the wetlands downslope.

Application 26-02 from Alan Morelli as agent for Ken Hershman to demolish two houses and replace them with a new house at 312 Bantam Lake Road was considered. Scott Meyers of Meyers Associates reviewed the plan. On a motion by Connie Trolle, seconded by Doreen Gagnon, it was **VOTED** unanimously to approve this application that should have no impact on the lake.

Other Business

There was one notification for pond treatment by Pond and Lake for the Maitland pond at 83 Isaiah Smith Lane.

There has been no application submitted for 56 Benedict Road.

There was no other business and the meeting was adjourned at 5:10 pm.
