The regular June 11, 2026 meeting was called to order by the chair at 4:05 pm downstairs in the Community Hall. Present were Doreen Gagnon, Robin Viola, and Mike Doyle. Connie Trolle and Clif Wheeler were unable to attend. Also present were Carrie Keppler and Dylan Hovey.

The minutes of the regular May 14, 2026 meeting were accepted as written.

Old Business

Application 26-07 from Carrie Keppler as agent for Nicholas Von Moltke for two barns at 68 West Street was considered. The pole barns will have frost walls and a concrete slab will be poured inside. Mr. Hovey explained that there will be no floor drains. One barn is for hay, the other for equipment and a workshop. No fertilizer or other chemicals will be stored in the barns. On a motion by Doreen Gagnon, seconded by Robin Viola, it was **VOTED** unanimously to approve this application that should have little impact on the wetland areas.

Michael Doyle reported that the Fire Department is going to clean the fire pond on Curtis Hill Road this summer.

Michael Doyle reported that he received a complaint regarding work done within the regulated area at 25 Curtis Hill Road. It was agreed to send a letter informing the property owner that an after-the-fact application for permit must be submitted to the Wetlands Commission.
