Application 26-09 was received from Lawrence Camp to clean a pond at 103 Litchfield Road. The reeds will be disposed of on the property and the muck spread on the fields. This will be on next month's agenda.

Application 26-10 was received from Kevin Mathews for a new house at 80 Stoddard Road. Also submitted was a site plan dated 5-20-26, revised 7-2-26, by Colby Engineering. This is Lot 2 of the Anthony LoFrisco subdivision. This will be on next month's agenda.

Application 26-11 was received from Monice and Neil Grabowski for weed and muck removal at 1451 Bantam Road (Mt Tom Pond). Monice Grabowski was told that she would need to submit a plan on how the work would be done. Some options were mentioned from past applications, but none include a machine in the water. It was suggested she contact the Northwest Conservation District. This will be on next month's agenda.

Michael Doyle reported we have had no response regarding the activity at 25 Curtis Hill Road. It was agreed the next step should be contacting our attorney.

Notification letter from Brian Hagan regarding a seawall of 2x2x6 concrete blocks four feet high and forty-two feet long on North Shore Road in Litchfield.
