

Ad Hoc Ordinance Review Committee for the Town of Morris, CT

Purpose:

For the general purpose of developing non-binding recommendations concerning certain ordinances. The committee shall be responsible to prepare such recommendations and provide such advice to the Board of Selectmen as it shall request. The committee shall have no executive or legislative powers.

Membership:

The committee shall be comprised of 5 voting members, one of which shall be the Town Clerk and four regular members who shall be residents of the town and of good character. The regular members shall be appointed as needed by the Board of Selectmen. Members shall serve without compensation, but the reasonable expenses of the committee or its members may be authorized with the prior approval of the Board of Selectmen.

Terms:

The regular members shall be appointed to serve: two members for one year and two members for two years. At the end of the initial terms, the regular members shall be appointed for a term of two years.

Officers:

The Committee shall elect from among its members, a Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary. The Chair shall preside at meetings of the committee. Such office shall not deprive the Chair or his/her vote on the any question. The Vice Chair shall preside at meetings of the committee in the absence or disability of the Chair. The Secretary shall serve to take minutes and perform administrative tasks for the committee.

Meetings:

The committee shall meet as needed. Agendas shall be filed with the Town Clerk and minutes shall be taken and filed with the Town Clerk.
