Morris Ordinance Committee  
Minutes of April 05, 2021

The regular meeting of the Morris Ordinance Committee was called to order at 1:34 pm by Chairman Gene Savickas. In attendance were Chairman Gene Savickas, Town Clerk Laura Halloran, Bev Huntley, Maureen Doyle, and guest First Selectman Tom Weik.

On a motion by Bev Huntley second by Laura Halloran it was voted to approve the minutes of October 05, 2020 as reported. Motion carried. **Unanimous.**

**New Business**

Maureen Doyle addressed hiring an Ordinance Enforcement Officer to oversee the enforcement of town ordinances. She expressed her concern that if we had no one enforcing ordinances it was futile to have an Ordinance Committee. While the Committee members were in favor of hiring and enforcement officer, First Selectman Weik stated he felt that there was no need for one at this time since there have been no issues concerning violations of ordinances and would like more information from the Committee as to why they felt the need for one. Bev Huntley made a motion, second by Laura Halloran, to table the issue. Motion carried. **Unanimous.**

**Old Business**

Intentional Baiting of Wildlife

First Selectman Weik submitted information from the Town of Simsbury and the State of New Jersey concerning this issue. Bev Huntley made a motion, second by Laura Halloran, to table the issue until the information submitted could be reviewed. Motion carried. **Unanimous.**

**Sale of Town Property (§31.04 (A))**

The Committee had questions regarding the proposed amendment to §31.04 (A) of the Town of Morris Connecticut, Code of Ordinances, which lowers the value of town property to be sold. First Selectman Weik was asked who would be responsible for determining the value of property to be sold. First Selectman Weik told the Committee that the department responsible for the property would determine the value. Maureen Doyle made a motion, second by Bev Huntley, to approve the change to §31.04 (A), allowing the sale of town property as described in the proposed amended ordinance. Motion carried. **Unanimous.**

Being no other business the meeting was adjourned at 1:57 pm.
