Veronica Florio made a motion to approve the amendment to the regulations to include Multi Family Housing, Mixed Use, and to comply with the statutory requirements of PA 23-142 to treat Licensed Family and Group and Child Care Homes as any other Single Family use. The effective date of the regulation will be November 30th 2023. Helen White seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
