1. Call to Order The Joint Finance Committee & Board of Education meeting held at Lakeview High School and via teleconference was called to order at 5:42 p.m. by Tiffany Parkhouse.

All members of the Finance Committee were present.

2. Pledge of Allegiance Tiffany Parkhouse invited everyone to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Approval of the Joint Finance Committee & Board of Education Special Meeting Minutes of February 26, 2026

Billie Jean Sideris made a motion for the Approval of the Joint Finance Committee & Board of Education Special Meeting Minutes of February 26, 2026. Krista Rizzo seconded the motion. There was no discussion. The motion passed with John Morosani abstaining.

4. Review & Discuss FY27 Budget

Dr. Villar opened this portion of the meeting and turned the floor over to Julia Cardillo to present the FY27 Budget. Julia Cardillo then conducted a line-by-line review of the Board of Education (BOE) modifications. These updates reflected changes to the initial FY27 Budget (presented on January 29, 2026) following the Joint Finance Committee and BOE meeting on February 26, 2026. Dr. Villar, Julia Cardillo, and Julie Haggard addressed questions that included but were not limited to handling of any surplus in FY26 budget, health insurance, and counselors at the elementary school level.

5. Review & Discuss FY27 Revenue

Julia Cardillo presented the FY27 Revenue and addressed a question regarding ASTE Tuition.

6. Public Comment

Individuals offering public comment should please state their first and last name and the town where they reside. Remarks should be limited to no more than three minutes. A maximum time limit of 30 minutes will be allocated for public comment at any one meeting. Individuals representing a common interest or topic may be asked to have one individual speak for the group. Public comments must be relevant to the meeting's

agenda. Speakers shall direct all comments to the Board, not to individual BOE members or administrators. Profane or vulgar language, partisan political statements, and comments related to the conduct or performance of staff are not permitted. Public comment is received without Board comment or response, the Board is to keep comments “under advisement.” However, BOE members may seek clarification or additional information from speakers through the Chairman.

No public comments offered.

Tiffany Parkhouse closed the meeting commenting it is anticipated the Board of Education will vote at its next meeting on April 9, 2026 to adopt, or not, the proposed FY27 Budget recommendation.
