
Sandy Beach Commission Minutes April 21, 2022

Old Business:

Restoration project - The Commission is waiting for estimates for roofing for the cabin. Todd Dyer will get estimates before the next meeting. The Commission is also waiting for updated cost information for window replacements. Other trees (along the driveway) may need to be taken down. Septic cleaning should take place before the beach opening.

New Business:

- Beach Manager Staffing for the 2022 season is in place for WSI, guard and gate positions. Two of the staff are taking WSI classes. Swim lesson sign-ups will be held June 4th and 18th from 10 AM 1 PM at the beach. Swim team is questionable at this time. Swim sessions will be: June 27- July 8, July 11- July 22, July 25- Aug 8. The beach will be open Memorial Day weekend and the following weekends. Full time daily opening will begin June 20th. Beach fees: Residents: \$75, Senior residents: \$0, Non-residents: \$150, Non-resident seniors: \$75. Minimum wages increase in July. Todd Dyer has been in touch with the TAHD regarding the snack bar.
- Forman School The crew team will be helping with the spring clean-up. Karen Brady is the contact person.
- Beach gate a temporary lock is still in place.
- Beach tree Jenn Parsons has been in touch with Mike Berry of WMF. He will provide a new tree this spring.
- Meeting Ed Ryle and Denise Parker met with the two First Selectmen at the beach. Discussion topics included insurance, commercial use of beach, dock storage at the beach, past and future beach improvements.
- Beach committees Sandy Beach shirts are in. Prices will be reduced on sign-up days. The Triathlon is being considered for 2022. Available dates are being investigated for a Saturday morning race.
