#### Old Business:

- a. The Walk With Ease program has been well received. Many would like to continue walking after the program ends. Dot DeLuca suggested walking around the Senior Center and Eldridge. Harriet Ellis reported that the custodian at James Morris School would open the school early for walking, but the request must come from Kristen Davila.
- b. Kristen was asked to contact the scouts to help clean out the Senior Center basement. New shelves would be needed. The basement could be used to store items for Beach and Recreation, as well as the Senior Center.

#### New Business:

- a. The dishwasher in the kitchen is not working properly. A repair service was called. The temperature probes were cleaned but the issue persists. A temporary solution is to use plastic silverware and cups. Kristen will look into the possibility of buying a sterilizing dishwasher or a household dishwasher with a sanitary rinse cycle.
- b. The fund raising appeal sent out in the mail raised \$210. Kristen will also email this appeal.
- c. Suggestions were made to do a Senior Outreach to promote the Senior Center. Dot suggested that Kristen attend one of the monthly meeting at Eldridge and talk about what is available at the Senior Center. Kristen suggested that commission members could make scripted calls to seniors in our town.
- d. Spring and summer programming will include the Ice Cream Social and the Lunch and Learn programs.
