

Medicare Open Enrollment

It's that time of year again! Medicare's open enrollment season is now until December 7. During this time, you will have the opportunity to make several changes. You can switch from Original Medicare to Medicare Advantage; you can shift from Medicare Advantage to Original Medicare; you can trade one Medicare Advantage policy for another; and you can buy a different Part D prescription drug plan.

Even if you're happy with your current Medicare coverage, it's important to review your coverage options for 2024. Here are a few reasons why:

- 1. Your needs may change. You may find you're going to the doctor more or less often, the prescription drugs you take may be different or you may need better access to health care services.
- 2. Benefits and costs can vary. Not all Medicare coverage options offer the same benefits. Plan benefits and costs can change from year-to-year. If you have a Medicare plan, check your Annual Notice of Changes (ANOC) to see

what's different for 2024.

3. New, more affordable Medicare plans may be available. The total cost, provider network and services offered are different between plans. Check if other plan options could better meet your needs or lower your out-of-pocket costs.

If you like your current health care coverage and it's still available in 2024, you don't need to take any action.

Shop and compare plans in our area. Compare 2024

coverage options and shop for plans. Get estimates of costs and review benefits offered by Medicare health and drug plans in our area. You can even compare plans based on their star rating for quality and performance.

Chair Yoga

shifting your focus off stressful thoughts. The movements are almost meditative and promote relaxation.
