I'm writing to let you know that I'm contemplating putting a proposal together to have our nipper bottle deposit revenue go to support this cost at RRDD1. We'd be happy to divide cost proportionally by population, which would have Winchester covering about half the total annual cost. If you are interested in pursuing this service at RRDD1 as well, let me know! I figure if we're all in agreement we can take it to the RRDD1 Board to make sure they're okay with the concept and then to our respective Boards of Selectmen for final financial approval. Good morning, all,

Blue Earth has created a quote estimating a monthly cost of \$348.00 to maintain a compost area at RRDD1 (see attached) and has provided an estimate for what it would cost each resident in our area to sign up for private compost pick-up services (~\$27.50 per month, see below). I think this is a fairly manageable cost on the RRDD1 side of things – I would be willing to have Winchester pay a portion of that out of our nipper bottle deposit income. Beyond that, I don't think it hurts to make residents aware that this service is also available to them at their house, but it's not something Winchester will want to pay to provide for all residents on a pick-up basis.
