**A. CODERRE, JEFFREY, APPLICANT/OWNER, 66 NORTH CANTON ROAD.  
TIMBER HARVEST**

The owner of the property, Jeff Coderre was present with the Forester, Thomas Trowbridge. This property is 79 acres with wetlands and a stream. They will harvest 130,000 board feet of timber over the next two years. They will not begin until January, 2019 and will only be working on site, when the site is dry. All best management practices will be followed. Mr. Trowbridge assured the commission that he would make sure the harvester had spill kits. They would also put corduroy in place with a timber bridge.
