Staff advised the commission that Mr. Fayer and Eugene Allen had come in to talk about some ideas for stabilizing the bank, specifically building a wall at the bottom of the slope. The commission asked staff to have Mr. Fayer come in with his plan and have Karen Nelson from Northwest Conservation review the plan. The commission also advised staff that Mr. Fayer appeared to be moving more soil up by the barn. Staff will contact Mr. Fayer to find out what is being done now.
