1. NEW APPLICATIONS: None

2. PUBLIC HEARINGS: None

3. PENDING APPLICATIONS:

A. NEURATH, SCOTT, applicant/owner, 210 Old North Road. Application for construction of addition to residence

This application was deemed regulated, non significant and has Farmington Valley Health approval. There were no additional comments. Chairman Greaser accepted a motion to grant the permit, with the following conditions:

1. Permanent markers shall be placed at 100 foot to 200 foot intervals along the surveyed wetlands boundaries.
2. Activity should follow 2002 Sedimentation and Erosion Guidelines, and be noted on the plan. Additional siltation controls should be incorporated in areas of additional exposure such as watercourses, roadways, etc.
3. Inland/Wetlands Enforcement Officer to be notified one week prior to construction in writing;
4. Any excess materials be removed from the site; (i.e. no stockpiling)
5. If individual site plans differ in any way from the approved plan, then the individual site plan must be resubmitted to the Wetlands Commission.
6. All vehicles working on site should be equipped with spill kits.

The motion was made by Tony Gorman, seconded by Fred Reeder and unanimously approved.

4. SHOW CAUSE, CEASE AND DESIST:

Larose, Robert, 65 Gavitt Road. Show cause, cease and desist. This remains state quo.

5. INLAND/WETLANDS ENFORCEMENT **OFFICER'S** REPORT:

Debbie updated the commission on the White Pines campsite work being done for the new septic system. Debbie has done spot checks at White Pines and found that the silt fence was in bad shape. She asked the workers on site to have the silt fence repaired by the next day and they complied.

6. ELECTION OF OFFICERS:
