Henry Todd made a motion to appoint Johanna Mann as moderator. Seconded by Greg Marlowe; unanimous.

Ms. Mann read the warning into the record:

1. Electors and others qualified to vote at Town Meeting are hereby warned of a Special Town Meeting for the Town of Canaan, Falls Village, CT to be held at the municipal offices at 108 Main Street on Monday, November 6, 2023 to act on the following: Shall the Town of Canaan approve the sale of the property at 35 Railroad Street for \$300,000.

- 2. Shall the Town of Canaan approve the exchange of property from Great Falls Property LLC, owner of the abutting land to the former firehouse, to the Town of Canaan, making the property a legal lot as well as giving Great Falls Property two easements being a pedestrian easement along the northern side of the property and a vehicular easement through the existing parking lot.
- 3. Shall the Town of Canaan approve the appropriation of up to \$10,000 from the Bridge Reserve Account #1702646689 to pay the final bill of Cardinal Engineering for the Cobble Road Culvert Project.
- 4. Shall the Town of Canaan approve the appropriation of up to \$10,000 for the replacement of the A/C unit at Town Hall with a heat pump from the 107/108 Property Reserve Account #170263056.

At the closing of the polls, the ballots will be counted and results reported. After the conclusion of this, the meeting will adjourn.
