November Election / Who – When – and Where’s

Who can vote in the November Election?

US Citizens who are registered can participate in voting. *Note: Former Watertown residents who are US Citizens should contact the Town Clerk’s office to determine eligibility*

Important Registration Dates:

October 16, 2026: Last day to register in person and mail-in. The Registrar of Voters will be open from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. for in person registration. All mail-in voter registration applications must be received or post-marked by this date in order to be accepted. The Online Voter Registration System will also close on this date at 11:59 p.m.

Voter Registration for Early Voting: Same Day Registration (SDR) is available at the Early Voting location during the early voting period (October 19th-November 1st)

November 2, 2026: Deadline for admitting those seeking to vote in the Election whose qualification as to age, citizenship, or residence was attained on or after October 16th. Registrar of Voter’s office will be open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

November 3, 2026: Same Day Registration/Voting available at Town Hall 6 a.m.-8 p.m.

ELECTION DAY VOTING: Tuesday, November 3, 2026, 6:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

Where can I vote?

***ABSENTEE VOTING:** Town Clerk’s Office, Town Hall, 108 Main St., Falls Village

****EARLY VOTING:** Senior Center, 107 Main St., Falls Village

ELECTION DAY VOTING: Town Hall, 108 Main St., Falls Village
Same Day Registration/Voting-for those who are not registered and wish to register and vote in person on Election Day
