Enclosed you will find the "marriage worksheet". I will use this information to print out your marriage license.

Both parties MUST appear in person to sign the license *during normal office hours*. Please remember to bring some form of photo id (driver's license or passport). If you do not have a photo id, please call to find other documents that you can bring to prove your identity.

Once you sign your license, it is valid for 65 days. The marriage license costs \$50. If you would like me to mail you a certified copy of your license once I have recorded it, there is an additional fee of \$20 per certified copy requested. Please remember, certified copies are available only *after* your officiator has returned the license to the Town Clerk and it has been recorded.

Please allow at least 30 minutes for processing your license when you come in to the Town Clerk's office.

Many people have asked about who is qualified to officiate at a marriage ceremony. Please refer to the enclosed flyer "Marriage License Laws of Connecticut."



Section 46b-20. Definitions.

As used in this chapter:

- (1) "Registrar" means the registrar of vital statistics
- (2) "Applicant" means applicant for a marriage license
- (3) "License" means marriage license; and(4) "Marriage" means the legal union of two persons.
