PROPOSAL FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR REPAIR OF BRIDGE NO. 05191 TOWN OF CANAAN, CT

ARTICLE I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project consists of preparing contract documents for the repairs to the superstructure of Bridge No. 05191. The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) recently performed an evaluation of the load-carrying capacity of the subject bridge following the most recent inspection of the bridge. This evaluation revealed that repairs are needed at nine stringer ends at the piers due to significant corrosion of the steel members. CTDOT requires either repairs to be made, or the bridge be closed to vehicular traffic (presently the bridge is posted for a 4-ton limit). The completed repairs will allow the Town of Canaan to keep the bridge open to truck traffic.

ARTICLE II. SCOPE OF SERVICES

Proposed Repairs

Proposed repairs will consist of installing supplemental web plates and bearing stiffeners to reinforce the ends of affected stringers at the piers. The work will require localized paint and rust removal and removal of existing deteriorated steel.

Proposed structural design services include the following tasks:

- 1 Review existing documents prepared by CTDOT, including latest Routine Bridge Inspection Report dated March 25, 2025, and Bridge Load Rating documentation.
- 2 Conduct site inspection of the affected stringers to verify existing conditions and to obtain field measurements required for the preparation of design of repairs.
- 3 Prepare design of repairs of the nine-stringer end location identified in the CT DOT May 9, 2025 letter from Mary Baker to the Town. Per CT DOT recommendations, all legal and EV rating factors will be above 1 after repairs are completed.
- 4 Prepare drawings and technical specifications for the proposed repairs.
- 5 Provide review of project submittals and limited technical consultation during construction. Site visits are not included as part of this work.



<u>Note:</u> Per CT DOT Inspection Frequency Change Request (BRI-8) which states the following, all inspection work will be done using ladders:

"March 2025 Inspection used a 30' UBIU, New Load Rating Report rates bridge unsafe for all trucks. Future inspections should be done with ladders."

Additionally, if required by CTDOT, the bridge load rating will be updated to reflect completed repairs.

Preparation of Contract Documents

Prepare 100% Design Submissions for review and comment by the town. The Contract Documents will be in a booklet form – Project Manual, which will include the "Front End" bidding and contract documents based on Town Canaan standard boiler plate. Prepare Notices to Contractor, Special Provisions and Technical Specifications based on the Connecticut Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Roads, Bridges, Facilities and Incidental Construction, Form 820, as amended as well as construction details for the various repair work.

Bidding and Award

Provide the Town with assistance throughout the bidding period, including answering contractor questions and issuing any required addenda. Cardinal will attend the pre-bid meeting, the bid opening, review and tabulate all bids received, review contractor qualifications, and make a recommendation of the lowest qualified bidder to the Town.

Construction Contract Administration

Upon the award of the construction contract pursuant to this Agreement, Cardinal Engineering Associates, Inc. shall provide the following Construction Contract Administration Services:

- 1 Review shop drawings and working drawings submitted by the contractor. It is assumed that a maximum of two reviews will be required for each submission.
- 2 Furnish consultation and advice during construction. This shall include the following:
 - i. Conduct preconstruction conference.
 - ii. Attend progress meetings.
 - iii. Analysis and review of job problems.
 - iv. Preparation of change orders.
- 3 Make periodic site visits.
- 4 Review Applications for Progress Payments made by the construction contractor.
