

## SELECTMAN'S OFFICE

The Selectmen met and paid the bills. Mrs. Elsie Arrigoni and Mr. Gaylord Newton came and talked to the Board about their present systems and we are going to have a Town Meeting to eliminate the sheets that are not necessary, but that they have been using.

Then two men from the Hartford Electric Light Co. came and presented the lighting plan for the Town to be carried out over the next five years. The Selectmen voted to take the plan to the Board of Finance. This will be a \$ 300.00 increase in the budget every year until the plan is completed.

The Third Selectman bought in three resolutions that the Democratic Town Committee had passed. One concerned Traffic Lights and the clerk is to write a letter to the Traffic Commission about a light at the Wallingford Road and one at Maiden Lane for the School Children. Another resolution concerned having speed limits posted on Town Roads, and the other one concerned calling a Town Meeting to appoint a Recreation Commission. Mr. Stender thought the second and third should be considered more thoroughly.

They discussed the Recreation Committee we have now and agreed on the following names, Mr. Walter Gregg, Mr. Ira Kerschner, Rev. Fell and Mr. Walter Camp. Mr. Stender was to check and see if Mr. Camp had any other replacement and if not than Mr. Wm. Cahill is to be the 5th. member.

They voted to appoint an assistant Fire Marshall as sometimes it is necessary to obtain a blasting permit and the Fire Marshall isn't always able to be available.

A list of things they want to ask the Town Attorney was mentioned and when they are all discussed with him, the ones that have to be settled by a Town Meeting will be taken care of in April and the rest will be taken care of at the next Selectmen's meeting. The question of the Assistant Fire Marshall, a Director of Recreation, the fee system for the Building Officer and the problem of the Assessor's sheets were to be taken up with the Town Attorney.

Mr. T.O. Bertz was appointed to the Library Board to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Mrs. Reba Ehlers.

The meeting adjourned until March 28, at 6:00 o'clock P.M.
