The Selectmen met and paid the bills. In answer to a letter from Mr. Suchanek regarding the fees earned from approving the location of the site of wells, Mr. Kerschner made a motion that if legally possible, the one dollar fee be paid to the Assistant Health Officer. The Clerk is to check on the legality.

Mr. Stender gave a report on the meeting he attended last Tuesday in Middletown on drugs. Committees are going to be formed and he stated that we should send representatives as Durham must be well informed on this very serious subject.

Mr. Kerschner brought up the subject of a Folk Festival in our neighboring Town and Mr. Stender made a motion that the Clerk send a letter to the Selectmen of Middlefield, stating that the Board of Selectmen are opposed to the Festival for the following reasons, Sanitation, Health, Transportation and Personal Welfare. Also that the Board would appreciate being kept informed of any action that the Town of Middlefield takes pertaining to the proposed Festival. Mr. Kerschner seconded the motion.

Mr. Stender made a motion that the Clerk contact the Recreation Committee and ask them to send a copy of their budget to the Selectmen as this should be included in their budget to be sent to the Board of Finance.

The Clerk mentioned that a group of students would like to use the upstairs of the Town Hall for plays and this was agreeable as long as the stage is there. *Members of the new Property assn, were present at the meeting.*

The meeting was adjourned until March 19th. at 6:00.
