BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING

March 13, 1980

The meeting was called to order at 7:32 p.m. Present: M. Foster Mather, First Selectman; Maryann P. Boord, Selectwoman; Gregory G. Curtis, Selectman. Also: Linda Dean.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved. 3-0

The correspondence was read and so noted.

The road specifications in zoning regulations were discussed. Final recommendations to be made subsequent to reviewing the widths of several existing roads and reviewing of grades.

The Board of Selectmen unanimously voted to go into Executive Session at 8:14 p.m. to discuss union negotiations. Executive Session unanimously adjourned.

G. Curtis reported two requests for street line painting: Howd Road and Foothills (lower end near Millbrook).

F. Mather moved that the Board of Selectmen present to two public hearings and town meeting the reappropriation of \$9,259.21 FRS funds unexpended from the Indian Lane project and appropriate it to the combined paving projects of Arbutus Street and Tuttle Road. Approved. 3-0

The meeting adjourned at 8:58 p.m.
