2. RESOLVED, that the Board of Selectmen has noted that the proposed budget from Regional School District #13 will cause a substantial tax increase in the Town of Durham and the Board of Selectmen hereby urges that the Governor and the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut act to appropriate an additional ADM Grant to Connecticut municipalities in the amount of \$75.00.
