WHEREAS the cost of materials, labor and machines necessary for the proper maintenance of town highways has greatly increased during the past three years, and,

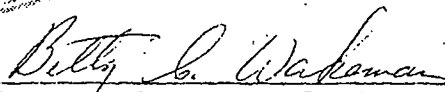
WHEREAS the volume of inter town traffic on the state's town roads has increased and will increase,
