BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING

January 4, 1979

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 P.M. In attendance: Gregory G. Curtis, First Selectman; Betty C. Wakeman, Selectwoman; Lewis G. Hinman, Selectman; Charles Mauro, William Moore, Ona McLaughlin, Linda Dean.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved. 3-0

The Financial Report was approved. 3-0

Mr. Curtis discussed a proposal on the purchase and use of a town garage site he had presented to the Planning and Zoning Commission on Jan. 3rd. The Commission responded favorably to the proposal.

Regular business session was postponed so that the board could review the Improvement Estimates and financing plan for the town garage prior to a joint session with the Board of Finance.

G. Paganetti reported to Mr. Curtis that the Firehouse Building Committee had paid \$1,800 for a building permit. They would like to have the money returned to their budget. This request will be given to the Board of Finance.

Mr. Curtis reported that a near serious situation at the High School had been handled by the state police, constables, and school personnel before becoming serious. A discussion between the school officials and the town officials resulted in the decision that the town would pay for 2 additional constables at all basketball games and one additional constable at all dances this season. Also, one or two state policemen will be on duty. The Board moved to utilize the budget funds set aside for constable patrolling for additional constables at High School games and dances. 3-0

William Leining's anniversary raise was approved by the Board. from \$3.62 to \$3.85 per hour. 3-0

The meeting adjourned at 9:50 P.M.
