Meeting of the Board of Selectmen
January 11, 1973

Last year the Town used a total of 1,027 cubic yards of sand. The First Selectmen reported that due to the significant ice problems, 937 cubic yards had allready been used this year.

The Selectmen will request Town Counsel to review expenditure requirements and procedures and issue an opinion to the Board concerning Revenue Sharing.

The second revenue sharing check for the Town has been received, bringing the total for 1972 \$45,453. Both checks have been deposited and are drawing interest. A meeting will be arranged with the Board of Finance to discuss disposition of these funds, and a call for a town meeting will be planned. The vote was 3-0.

The Board of Selectmen will hold it's regular 1973 meetings on the second and fourth Thursday's of each month. The vote was 3-0.

The loan from Mr. Roger Clark for the cemetary property has been paid in full.

The Selectmen are continuing their study of Peddler's regulations for Durham, pending action this Spring by the Board.

A copy of the new proposal by the Durham Historic District Committee has been received and acknowledged.
