Letter from the Board of Finance: a) tabled request for \$1800 from the Firehouse Building Committee; b) recommended \$101,900 for the purchase and improvement of the Arrigoni property for a town garage and that the purchase be financed over a 10 year purchase; 2-0.2) Fire Marshal's report for Jan. 1 - Dec. 31, 1978 was received from Joseph Planeta; 3) Letter received from Chris Dodd concerning his actions relating to the impending CETA cutbacks; 4) The Middlesex United Way Campaign met with Mr. Curtis to discuss the possibility of Durham becoming a United Way Community. The fall of 1979 would be the first campaign for Durham.

The Board members discussed the forthcoming town meeting for the purchase of a town garage and the hiring of a resident state trooper.
