The Selectmen met at 7:00 and paid the bills. A motion was made and seconded to appoint Mr. Alfred Wakeman to the Durham Development Commission. They agreed to make voters on January 22, from 6 to 8:00 P.M., but the dates to meet for the regular Selectmen's meetings for the entire year was tabled until the voter making session as each night seems to be filled.

Mr. Kerschner stated that a release was going to be drawn up by the Town Counsel, for snowmobiles owners to sign when using the White Property, but as yet it has not been received. He also brought up the problem of keeping the Dump open more days because of the garbage collectors. More consideration must be given to this subject before making up the new Budget.

January 26th. was picked as the date for a Town Meeting to accept the Historical District, accept Guire Road, and also to change the voting place.

Mr. George Eames has requested that a temporary office be made for him in the Town Hall as soon as possible for the collection of taxes. Mr. Stender made a motion that \$375.00 be spent from our present Budget to set up a temporary office until plans for remodeling the present Town Hall or plans for building a new Town Hall be completed. The First Selectman seconded the motion. Mr. Kerschner opposed the motion.

Mr. Stender's letter of Dec. 8, 1969 was acknowledged and his letter of January 7, 1970 was accepted.

Mr. Kerschner stated that a radio number for communication for the Ambulance will be needed in the future and the situation should be investigated.

Our new revaluation was discussed, particularly the 25% deduction that was given to Main Street residents. The only changes that could be made would have to be made by the Board of Tax Review. They would have to ask the Tax Commissioner to use the last Grand List instead of the new list.

The Clerk was instructed to call the Guilford Police Dept. to arrange another training session for the constables.

The meeting was attended by Mrs. Stuart Dudley, Mrs. Paul Mallinson, Mrs. Charles Church Jr. Mr. Daniel Guire, Mr. Ronald Markham, Mr. Merle Ackert and Mr. Albert Johnson.

The Selectmen adjourned until January 22, at 6:00 P.M.
