The Cemetery Committee is going to be asked to attend a meeting with the Selectmen concerning the new property.

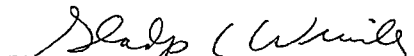
The Selectmen set the same night, the second Thursday of each month, as the meeting night for the coming year.
