Mr. Stender made a motion and Mr. Kerschner seconded the motion, to give approval of his attendance at school and to ask the Board of Finance for any sums that are spent for the course.

They discussed a letter from Mr. Hallworth and agreed that cards be made up for identification purposes and to have marker plates made for the cars. The matter of red lights was tabled. The Clerk was instructed to answer the letter.

The Clerk reported that the next training session for the Constables would be on January 29, at 8:00 at the Town Hall.

The third Thursday was set as the night for voter making sessions for every month except when set by law.

The second Thursday of every month was set as the Selectmen's meeting night, at 8:00 at the office of the First Selectman.
