The appointments to the Charter Revision Commission are still being considered. It was tabled for 2 weeks until the Board of Selectmen's Meeting of Feb. 5, 1976.

The Board granted the request of the Independent Rescue Service to use the Green on April 24, 1976, for a Tag Sale.

It was decided that tickets will be issued by patrolling constables to owners of cars parked on town roads during winter storms (while snow, sleet, etc. is falling) or within 24 hours after a storm stops or between the hours of 11 P.M. and 7 A.M.

White Farm Improvement Project: Rough estimates of improvements were discussed. The list of improvements was condensed to 11 items: skating pond, fish pond, pavilion, bridge, picnic area, service facility, softball field, parking lot, road, fencing, drainage. The list of improvements are the result of strong suggestions by townspeople and Tim Rosenhan, former CETA designer. Contributions by local organizations were also discussed. Soil conservationists from the Extension Service will be looking over the site area for recommendations during the upcoming week.

The Board of Selectmen set a firm date of February 23, 1976, Monday night, 8:00 P.M. at the Frank Ward Strong School for a Town Meeting to be held re: the White Farm Improvement Project.
