Subject: Title VI allocation for Fiscal Year '77

The Title VI allocation for fiscal year '77 for the Balance of State Connecticut Prime Sponsor is \$10,186,212. This amount is not sufficient to support until September 30, 1977 the 2184 PSE positions which Title VI regulations mandate us to sustain. Therefore, we have funded all municipalities for a seven month period. This method was initiated to avoid layoffs and to assure continuation of vital public services.

In order that we may, in the absence of additional funding, extend our funding capabilities for the full fiscal year, we are requesting your cooperation as follows:

1. Openings occurring due to attrition shall not be filled.
2. Additional positions shall not be created.

Through our unified efforts it will be possible for us to serve the eligible citizens of Connecticut and carry out the mandates of CETA.
