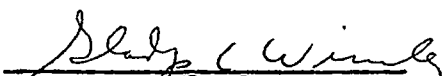


SELECTMAN'S OFFICE

The Board of Selectmen met and paid the bills. They finally paid Mr. Libby's bill the same as he agreed in conversation with Mr. Markham. Mrs. Hatch came to the meeting to discuss various things. One was about the voting machines being checked over and Mr. Stender stated that it was six or seven years since the older machine had been checked and the new machine was never checked. He recommended that Mrs. Hatch write and request they come to check them. She also mentioned that the ordinance committee should work on the ordinances but the Clerk thought it had been done just one year ago and she was going to write a letter to this affect. Then she brought up the matter of reports of various boards being open to the public and the Selectmen were of the opinion that all the records were in safe places but she could ask Mr. Adorno for a clarification if she wants too. They agreed to make voters from 10:00 to 12:00 on Saturday Feb. 15, 1964. Mr. Markham mentioned talking to Mr. Avery about the boys over sixteen wanting to work. There isn't much that boys between sixteen and eighteen are allowed to do.
