The Selectmen met and paid the bills. It was decided to pay Mr. Vance for the bridge welding and any other work that we have to do on the Maiden Lane Bridge which was smashed by a car. The owner's Insurance Co. will be asked to reimburse the Town.

After a discussion of Harvey Road, Mr. Stender stated that we should not consider these old wood roads as Town accepted roads as long as they are not on our State approved map and we haven't maintained them in the past.

The Selectmen discussed the borrowing of \$ 1,500,000.00 at this time, at the request of the Durham School Building Committee. It was voted to have Mr. Stender make the necessary arrangements with the Conn. Bank & Trust Co. to meet the School Building Committee needs as approved at a Town Meeting held May 1, 1967.

Mr. Stender presented a letter for the Durham School Building Committee recommending that the Selectmen request the Board of Education to turn the five or six acres of land on the north side of the Brewster School over to the town due to the fact that no further building can be done on this site and it could be used for other Town purposes. The Selectmen voted to carry out this recommendation and Mr. Stender was appointed to represent the Selectmen in this matter.

The Selectmen worked on the budget.
