BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING February 14, 1980

The Board of Selectmen's Meeting of February 14, 1980, was called to order at 7:35 p.m. by First Selectman M. Foster Mather; Maryann P. Boord, Selectwoman, and Gregory G. Curtis, Selectman, were present. The Board held an informal discussion period.

At 7:47 p.m. F. Mather moved to go into Executive Session to discuss union negotiations; seconded by M. Boord; approved unanimously. Others present: Carl Otte, Philip Albert, Vincent Marino, Attorney Robert Poliner. On a motion by F. Mather, seconded by M. Boord, and approved with 3 ayes, March 10, 1980, was established as the date of the first meeting with the union negotiators (7:30 p.m., town hall, board room). At 10:14 p.m. the board moved unanimously to go out of executive session.

G. Curtis moved approval of the minutes of the previous meeting; seconded by M. Boord; 3 ayes.

M. Boord moved to recommend Selectmens' salaries be \$900 each; 2 ayes (Boord, Curtis); 1 abstention (Mather).

M. Boord moved to recommend a First Selectman's salary of \$12,000; seconded by F. Mather; 2 ayes (Boord, Mather); 1 no (Curtis).

The proposed letter to be sent to the ambulance corps from the Board of Selectmen was approved.

G. Curtis moved to approve the hearing notice; seconded by M. Boord; 3 ayes.

The Board approved the adjournment of the meeting at 10:28 p.m.
