BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING February 18, 1982

The meeting was called to order by First Selectman M. Foster Mather. G. Curtis was present, M. Boord absent. Mr. Stephen Feuser of Johnson Lane was present.

G. Curtis moved the minutes of the previous meeting be approved as written (Feb. 4, 1982); seconded by M. F. Mather; 2 ayes:

Correspondence was read.

M. Foster Mather nominated Janet Moore as Assistant Treasurer; seconded by G. Curtis; 2 ayes..

Several budgets were reviewed: G. Curtis recommended dropping the Cherry Lane drainage project in order to keep the same money figure in the highway budget as last year. M. Foster Mather suggested presenting the highway budget as is to the Board of Finance with the suggestion that if something needs to be cut, that they start with Cherry Lane.

G. Curtis mentioned the need for a postal drop in the north end of town, near the Gateway. He also mentioned a drainage problem at the foot of Foot Hill Rd. near Salvatore DePaolo's house.
