The Selectmen met at 6:00 at the Town Hall. Mr. Vance made a motion to reappoint Mr. Driscoll as Dog Warden and Mr. Wimler seconded it.

Mr. Stender stated that the Community Bank of North Branford, Durham Branch, requests that in case of a Bank Disaster, the Town allow the Bank to set up temporarily in the Town Hall. The Selectmen granted this permission, with the condition that the Town would assume no responsibility nor would they be liable in any way for any problems which might arise.

The Clerk was instructed to talk to Mr. Curtis concerning the request of the Merion Turf Farm wanting to rent the White Farm.

The Hartford National Bank would like to come to a Selectmen's meeting to discuss their Computer System and it was decided to have them attend the March 27th. meeting when the Selectmen are making voters.

The Durham School Building Committee requested that the Selectmen have available \$23,500.00, as voted at the Jan. 27th. meeting; and Mr. Stender suggested that the Selectmen see if they can make arrangements for the total amount for the Reservoir and school sites to be available, and if not possible, to temporarily borrow the \$23,500.00 at this time. Mr. Wimler moved that Mr. Stender be made the Selectmen's agent to take care of this.

The Selectmen adjourned until Feb. 27th. at 7:00 at the First Selectmans Office. The Recreation Committee is coming to talk about their budget for the new year.
