BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING

February 26, 1981

The February 26, 1981, meeting of the Board of Selectmen was called to order at 7:35 P.M. by First Selectman M. Foster Mather. Gregory G. Curtis, Selectman, and Maryann P. Boord, Selectwoman, were present. Also present: R. W. Moeller, Roger Kleeman.

On a motion by G. Curtis, seconded by F. Mather, the minutes of the February 19, 1981, meeting were approved; 3 ayes.

A discussion of the Annual Muster sponsored by the Coginchaug Jr. Ancients Fife and Drum Dorps was discussed and the board chose to have auxiliary troopers close the road.

F. Mather moved to appoint the following to the CHARTER REVISION COMMISSION: George Zeeb, Charles Mauro, Robert Poliner, Gladys Wimler, Louise Scott, Trudi Bird, Merle Ackert; seconded by M. Boord; 3 ayes.

Applications for the position of road foreman were reviewed. March 3, 1981, Tuesday, the Board of Selectmen will interview the selected candidates.

The date for Anna May Spooner's grievance hearing was set for 2 P.M. March 5, at the town hall and the Selectmen's meeting will follow.

R. W. Moeller reported to the Board for the Zoning Board of Appeals that Mr. Bastura is seeking certification from the state superior court.

407 Town Counsel \$10,000 approved; G. Curtis requested a cost per hour breakdown for the 2 lawyers involved.

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413 Zoning Board of Appeals \$520; F. Mather moved approval, seconded by G. Curtis; 3 ayes.

420-421 Board of Assessors; G. Curtis felt strongly that all raises should be 7%. He also strongly protested the Board of Finance granting a \$1,000 increase to the Town Engineer instead of 7%. F. Mather noted that 7% salary figures would be for the Assessor: \$10,015; for the Assistant: \$10,037. He further noted that all union people should be in at 7%.

423-424 Tax Collector; M. Boord recommended salary at \$7,900; the board approved the remainder of the request.

427-428 Town Clerk; pass to Board of Finance.

459 Civil Preparedness request \$2,033; leave to Board of Finance without reaction; recommendation to Board of Finance to use sharp axe.

501 Director of Health \$2,280; Board approved.

508 Community Mental Health Clinic; F. Mather moved to recommend \$1,125 to Board of Finance; seconded by G. Curtis; M. Boord abstained.

513 MCT \$9,000; G. Curtis wanted to wait for L. Jodoin to talk to the Board of Finance. F. Mather stated he generally approved of the service; passed to Board of Finance.

F. Mather discussed the upcoming meeting with the FHA about the landfill wells and requested input from the other board members.

The meeting adjourned at 10:43 P.M.
