BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING March 4, 1982

Re Minutes of previous meeting: G. Curtis moved approval; F. Mather seconded; 3 ayes.

F. Mather relayed a complaint from Jeff Richards re heavy truck traffic over the old Higganum Road.

Discussion with the Board of Finance.

The Board reviewed a letter from Northeast Utilities -- the town will be replaced by a new type of light unless otherwise requested by historic districts, etc. The Historic District Commission has requested that the same lights be replaced with the same kind of lights in the historic district. The Board of Selectmen will go along with the Historic District request.

Letter from Storer Communications dated 2/3/82 re cable tv installation. There are no poles on Haddam Quarter Road for 1290 feet. F. Mather noted that the poles could be in the way during future work on that road unless properly placed. Discussion about surveying the road. This is the shortest approach into Durham. F. Mather will tell them of our plans for drainage on that road in the future.

F. Mather moved the Board recommend the appointment of the Building Inspector as Municipal Administrative Officer relative to Section 19-402 and 19-403e of the General Statutes and Section 126.0 of the Basic Building Code; seconded by G. Curtis; 3 ayes.
