Minutes of Meeting of Board of Selectmen

March 8, 1973

Selectman, Reed Hayes suggested to the Board that the town no longer accept requests for approval of subdivision roads as official town roads between October 15 and April 15th and that this suggestion be discussed with the Town Engineer in anticipation of possible formal action. A letter will be sent to the Town Engineer requesting his opinion.

The Board will recommend to Town Meeting that the town accept Wildwood Circle as a town road. Vote was 3-0.

The formal name of the constables serving as a group under direction of the Board of Selectmen shall be Durham Constables. Vote being 3-0.

A request to appropriate \$100. to the Historic District Committee was approved and will be forwarded to the Board of Finance with a recommendation that such funds be appropriated from the Contingency Fund. The funds are necessary to support legally required publicity concerning hearings and town meetings on the subject. Vote was 3-0.

A Town Meeting will be called as soon as possible with the following items on the call:

Approval of Howard Road, a portion of Wagon Wheel Road and Wildwood Circle as town roads.

Execution of a quit claim deed to the Knights of Pythias.

Change the date of the Annual Budget Hearing from May 7th to May 14th, 1973.

A letter from Mrs. Genevieve Brennan of Howd Road requesting authorization to install curbing on Howd Road for the purpose of containing drainage problems was acknowledged. The Town Engineer will be requested to investigate.

The following appropriations will be requested of the Board of Finance in writing;

From a State Grant to the Town under HB 8022: \$2220.00 to be added to the Highway Maintenance portion of the 1972-1973 Selectmen's Budget.

From the Contingency Fund: \$100. for a sump pump for the Town Hall.

The budget requests for which the Selectmen are responsible were prepared and will be forwarded to the Board of Finance.

The meeting adjourned at 2:00AM.
