BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING

March 8, 1979

Approved minutes of previous meeting. 3-0

Reviewed the financial report.

Mr. Hinman moved to support the Historic Main Street Walking Tour. 3-0

Approved revised Town Hall Improvement budget at \$2,318.00. 3-0

Approved Old Firehouse budget; revised to \$2,410. 3-0

Board voted to appoint Lewis G. Hinman as Acting First Selectman for the period March 26 through April 9. 3-0

Board voted to close Arbutus Street on March 9, 1979, because of its hazardous condition. 3-0

Discussion of Assessor Budget: recommended change of assessor salary to \$9,360 for 20 hours per week average. 3-0

Joined Board of Finance at 8:40 P.M. to discuss multiple budgets. At this meeting it was pointed out that an emergency need exists on Arbutus Street and Haddam Quarter Road for the expenditure of \$2,250 of crushed rock to stabilize the road condition. It was also pointed out that an additional \$4,600 would be needed for paving. These expenditures are in excess of this year's budget but the work would have to be done immediately.

The Board of Selectmen's meeting reconvened at 10:45 P.M. to give priority to road projects: 1) Haddam Quarter Road, Foot Hills 2) Haddam Quarter Road, Carriage Drive 3) Arbutus Street 4) Coe Road 5) Cream Pot Road.

Adjourned at 11:05 P.M.
