Mrs. Arrigoni came and talked to the Selectmen concerning the work being done by a Bank Data Machine for the Abstract Book, Rate Book and etc. They also agreed for her to get a typewriter. Then Mr. Rich came and talked about insurance for the Town and how a Blanket Policy will save the Town a large amount of money. He was given authorization to cancel the present policies and issue a new policy called a Comprehensive Bussiness Policy.

The Board went on record as being in favor of a State Highway Garage being built in Durham and will assist them in any way possible and will go to the Planning Commission to help them.

They appointed Frank Davis as Dog Warden and appointed Mr. Herbert Patterson as a member of the Conservation Commission for a five year term. They appointed Mr. Carl Erickson as a member of the Durham School Study Commission.

Mr. Markham made a motion that the Board of Selectmen send a letter to the Board of Finance stating that the Board feels that possable expenditures by various boards be kept at a minimum as the total amount of all the Boards and Commissions may be excessive. Our grand list this year has not expanded enough to warrent any large expenditures.
