The Selectmen will contact the Board of Finance at their next meeting concerning the funds that would be necessary.

A letter was received from Congressman Robert Steele stating that under the proposed revenue-sharing plan of President Nixon, the Town would receive \$ 29,753.00. He is supporting this bill to help the towns.

They adjourned until 6:00 o'clock March 18, 1971 when they will make voters and present the Selectmen's budget to the ~~Town~~ Board of Finance.
