The Selectmen held a Special Meeting to work on the Budget as the Board of Finance want it ahead of time to look at it. They appointed Mr. Serafino Garbarino, Mr. Louis Adamoli, and Mr. Maynard Stender as special constables for the Rod and Gun Club. Then Mr. Stender made a motion as follows:

The Board of Selectmen will appoint a Recreation Committee of five to serve from now until Nov. 1st. at that time the same or another committee will be appointed for a year.

The Committee will appoint their own Chairman and Secretary and report periodically to the Selectmen as to any problem that might arise or of anything that the Selectmen could do to be of assistance.

The Committee will try to get together with the various recreational groups or individuals that are interested in these activities and help to schedule their activities.

They will then contact the Board of Education, School Administration or any other town agents that would have facilities to meet their needs. They (the agents) will assign the facilities and time to the individual groups.

The committee should not take over any group and run it. The Committee is as follows: Wally Camp, Coston Towns, Frank Johnson, Donald Knickerbocker and Burrill Gray.
