The Selectmen made voters and had a meeting also. They accepted Rev. Fell's letter of resignation with regret from the Recreation Committee. He stated that he was not able to attend the meetings as he had previous commitments. They appointed Mr. George Paganetti to replace him. Then they discussed the various sums of money that have to paid out over the original budget. They voted to recommend to the Board of Finance the following three items to be paid from the General Fund.

1. \$ 19,000.00 - paid off on the \$ 128,575.00 note.
2. \$ 1,700.00 - attorney's fees for the Reservoir closings.
3. \$ 4,733.17 - paid for interest on borrowed government portion of Reservoir money.
4. \$ 1,250.00 - to be paid from the Contingency Fund for Building Code expences, including Building Officer's Salary according to Town Meeting vote.
5. \$ 1,500.00 to be paid to the Board of Education for a School Salary shortage, from the General Fund. This will be reimbursed to the Town from Reginal Board # 13.

If these items are approved by the Board of Finance, they will be brought before a Town Meeting as soon as possible.
